3. POLE & AERIAL POLICIES

Pole Policies - Please, NO wearing of lotion or any substance that may cause the poles to become slippery. Poles may damage jewelry so please remove if you do not want your jewelry to get damaged.

An instructor must be present while using poles.

There is no jumping, running and jumping on poles.

Do not attempt pole tricks that have not been taught to you by an instructor.

Always ask for assistance when executing a move that you have not been approved to do alone.

Do not teach fellow clients pole tricks.

Please let the instructor do the teaching of pole tricks.

Only do moves that are within your ability.

Do not participate if you are under the influence of alcohol or any other mind-altering chemicals. is strictly prohibited.

Aerial & Acrobatic Policies - An instructor must be present while using acrobatic and aerial equipment.

Do not attempt acrobatic and aerial moves that have not been taught to you by an instructor.

Always ask for assistance when executing a move that you have not been approved to do alone.

Do not teach fellow clients aerial moves. Please let the instructor do the teaching of aerial moves.

Only do moves that are within your ability.

Do not wear jewelry or clothing that may cause damage to acrobatic and aerial equipment.

Do not participate if you are under the influence of alcohol or any other mind-altering chemicals.
